

**RESOLUTION NO. 48/2025  
OF THE SENATE  
OF THE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY OF WARSAW  
of 14 July 2025**

**on the agreement with the Student Council of the Medical University of Warsaw -  
Study Regulations adopted by Resolution No. 14/2025 of the Senate of the Medical  
University of Warsaw**

Pursuant to Article 75 paragraph 3 in conjunction with Article 28 paragraph 1 point 2 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571) and § 30 paragraph 1 point 2 of the Statutes of the Medical University of Warsaw, it is resolved as follows:

§ 1.

Following consultation with the Student Self-Government of the Medical University of Warsaw, the following amendments are made to the Regulations of the Medical University of Warsaw, adopted by Resolution No. 14/2025 of the Senate of the Medical University of Warsaw on 28 April 2025:

**1) In § 23 paragraph 7**

**current wording:**

*"7. In the event of a justified absence from a credit or partial credit examination in accordance with § 24, the student shall be entitled to a credit or partial credit examination on the next scheduled date organised by the unit. Absence from the assessment on the last date set by the unit does not oblige the head of the unit to set another assessment date. The head of the unit decides on the possibility of setting an extraordinary assessment date, taking into account the fulfilment of other obligations by the unit."*

**is replaced by the following:**

*"7. In the event of a justified absence from a credit or partial credit examination justified in accordance with § 24, the student shall be entitled to a credit or partial credit examination on the next scheduled date organised by the unit. **In the event of absence also on the last date scheduled by the unit, the head of the unit shall set a date for the assessment by the end of the semester, provided that this is permitted by the rules of the academic year established in accordance with § 4 par. 2.**"*

**2) In § 23 paragraph 10**

**current wording:**

*'10. In extraordinary circumstances, with the consent of the Dean, it is possible to change the form and mode of assessment announced in accordance with paragraph 2, but no later than two weeks before the date of the assessment or examination.'*

**is replaced by the following:**

*'10. In exceptional circumstances, with the consent of the Dean, it is possible to change the form and mode of assessment announced in accordance with paragraph 2, but no later than two weeks before the assessment date.'*

**3) In § 25 paragraph 3**

**current wording:**

*"3. The manner, form and deadline for making up for absences (catching up on classes) resulting from justified absences from classes for the reasons specified in paragraph 1 shall be determined by the head of the teaching unit conducting the classes in such a way that catching up on classes does not interfere with other classes according to the study plan. Arrears should be made up by the end of the semester. Making up for arrears at a later date requires the consent of the dean."*

**is replaced by the following:**

*"3. The manner, form and deadline for making up for absences (catching up on classes) resulting from justified absences from classes for the reasons specified in paragraph 1 shall be determined by the head of the teaching unit conducting the classes in such a way that catching up on classes does not interfere with other classes according to the study plan. Arrears should be made up by the end of the semester. Making up for arrears at a later date requires the consent of the dean."*

**4) In § 28 paragraph 7**

**current wording:**

*"7. In the event of an absence from an examination justified in accordance with § 24, the student has the right to take the examination on the next scheduled examination date organised by the unit. Absence from the exam on the last date set by the unit does not oblige the head of the unit to set another exam date. The head of the unit decides on the possibility of setting an extraordinary exam date, taking into account the fulfilment of other obligations by the unit."*

**is replaced by the following:**

*"7. In the event of an absence from an examination justified in accordance with § 24, the student shall have the right to take the examination on the next scheduled examination date organised by the unit. In the event of absence also on the last date scheduled by the unit, the head of the unit shall set the date of the examination by the end of the semester, provided that the rules of the academic year established in accordance with § 4 par.2 allow for this."*

§ 2.

Following consultation with the Student Council of the Medical University of Warsaw, and taking into account the changes specified in § 1, the Study Regulations of the Medical University of Warsaw shall be introduced on 1 October 2025, as set out in the Appendix to this resolution.

§ 3.

1. On 1 October 2025, Resolution No. 9/2023 of the Senate of the Medical University of Warsaw of 24 April 2023 on the introduction of the Study Regulations at the Medical University of Warsaw shall expire.
2. The resolution shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
