We, the students of Warsaw Medical University

I. General Principles/Rules

- 1. We are open to new knowledge and ready to acquire new skills and competences,
- 2. Our conduct is guided by generally accepted ethical standards and fundamental academic values, such as truth, reliability and responsibility,
- 3. We comply with the laws and customs of the Medical University of Warsaw,
- 4. We protect the good name and property of the University, and we shape its positive image with our conduct
- 5. We respect the dignity of all members of the WUM academic community and build relationships with them based on honesty, kindness and tolerance,
- 6. We apply and promote the principles of a healthy lifestyle,
- 7. We call out unfair and unethical behavior of the WUM academic community members;

II. Student conduct towards academic teachers and other University employees

- 1. We respect the University authorities and employees and behave in a way that commands their respect,
- 2. We fairly evaluate teachers and other University employees in student surveys,
- 3. We fulfill our obligations conscientiously and honestly, in particular:
 - a) we actively and systematically participate in classes and prepare for them,

 - c) we write tests, exams, diploma theses independently and comply with copyright and intellectual property laws and regulations
