# **Admissions**

At Medical University of Warsaw (MUW), admission to the 6-year Medical Program is assessed based on proof of English language proficiency and the following two criteria:

**Criterion 1.** Your final grades in Biology, Chemistry and Physics or Mathematics on your high school-leaving examination certificate (high school diploma) and,

**Criterion 2.** Your score from either of the following tests: Medical University of Warsaw English Division competency test, BMAT, MCAT, GAMSAT, UCAT, HPAT or university GPA.

# Make the MUW!

To apply to the Medical University of Warsaw 6-year Medical Program, register online via our online **Recruitment System (ORS)** https://recruitment.wum.edu.pl

You will need to fill in your **ORS** application with information and documents throughout the application process. Please don't miss a step and register before the deadline! The last day to register online is **June 28, 2024**.

The ORS generates your unique ID number, account number for fee payments, and password. You need to remember these for the application process.





## The application fee depends on the way you plan to complete the admission process:

- A candidate who writes the Medical University of Warsaw (MUW) competency t est.
  Register via our *ORS* to write the MUW competency test. Mark the high school
  leaving certificate option that best describes the one you have in your online
  application.
- A candidate who submits his/her BMAT, MCAT, UCAT, GAMSAT or HPAT score or holds a Bachelor of Science (BSc) or Master of Science (MSc) degree.

If you are missing any of the obligatory subjects (as required in Criterion 1), it is possible to be tested by the Medical University of Warsaw in this subject. Please write to the English Division Admissions Office at *recruitment@wum.edu.pl* to make the necessary arrangements.



At the Medical University of Warsaw (MUW), we accept BMAT, MCAT, UCAT, GAMSAT, HPAT scores, as well as, university GPA scores. However, most of our candidates write the MUW competency test.

The MUW competency test consists of 80 multiple-choice questions in premedical sciences, reasoning, and critical thinking skills. The test verifies the candidate's knowledge of biology, chemistry at the high school level, analytical skills and the ability to solve problems logically. The test requires no especial education or preparation.

The MUW competency test is organized on the online examination platform. While the exam dates are fixed, you choose the test time that suits you best, according to the GMT of the country where you live (your country of residence).

You can write the MUW competency test from anywhere in the world, at any time, at any of these dates, but **ONLY ONCE** during the recruitment cycle.

## Competency test session dates for academic year 2024/2025:

April 13, 14, 27 and 28 May 11, 12, 25 and 26 June 8, 9, 22 and 23 July 6 and 7





You will be informed via the Online Recruitment System (ORS) if your status is "QUALIFIED" to be admitted to the 6-year Medical Program.

To accept our offer, you must reply by email and pay a non-refundable place confirmation fee (after starting the course this fee is counted towards the tuition fee).

The Admission Board will guarantee your place in the 6-year Medical Program ONLY once you have provided certified copies of all the required documents to the Admission Office. The academic year 2024/2025 starts on October 1, 2024.

The tuition fee must be paid in full by October 15, 2024\*.
